Income Management, Sharing rule, Intra-household Collective Labor Supply

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Abstract

In this paper, the intra-household collective labor supply model is applied to examine the relation among income management, the sharing rule and husband and wife's labor supply. The wife's income management of the total household income is positively correlated to the sharing rule. The results indicate that factors positively (or negatively) influence the proxy of a wife's bargaining power and affect the share of a wife's income management of the household income in the same direction.
